

Solar Eclipse Rally TXABCD 2023

Saturday morning October 14 is the start of another fun time at Texas All British Car Days. Meet in the Salt Lick parking lot (3350 E. Palm aka Hwy 79 Dell Diamond complex) at 10:30 for the drivers meeting. Or...just come over to <a href="Rudy's">Rudy's</a> in Round Rock for tacos and coffee at 8:30 and travel there with the group!

The rally will be run in two legs, the first in the Time-Speed-Distance style where the driver and navigator will attempt to run the route at the posted speed-limit and arrive at the destination without missing any turns. Easy-peasy! The second leg will be the gimmick style where the competitors will have to spot features along the way in order to answer questions found on their instruction sheet. Even a caveman can do it! First car out at 11 AM. Route instructions will be handed out as the cars begin the drive.

A lunch break is scheduled between the legs at the famous <u>South Side Market</u> in Elgin. Yummy! The first car should arrive there about noon. The rally ends at the Homewood Suits in Round Rock. The hospitality suite will open at 2 PM, just in time for the arrival of the first car. Those folks who have pre-registered can pick up their regalia and goody bags until 4PM, after which we move out to the back-parking lot for a tail-gate party!

As a bonus this year, we have arranged a full eclipse of the sun at noon. This will take place during the rally as an added attraction. Viewing glasses will be provided to the first 50 competitors!
